



ATLANTA FRANCOFONIE FESTIVAL – March 2017

Children drawing contest to celebrating the French Language from around the world!
The aim of the contest is to portray the richness and particularities of the world's francophone cultures.

Open to elementary-school (level 1) and middle-school (level 2) students from the greater Atlanta area. Prizes will be awarded to 20 participants in each level.

Participation rules:

- 1. Learn French at an elementary or middle school** from the greater Atlanta area
- 2. Drawing must be executed by an individual, not a team. One word one drawing**
- 3. Must use one of the provided words in the drawing (see PowerPoint attached)**
- 4. Drawing must be made with colored pencils, on a letter-format sheet of paper, to ensure uniformity.**
- 5. Must provide a short written description of the drawing** (one sentence for elementary-school participants, a few sentences for those attending middle-school).
- 6. On the back of the drawing, write down the participant's name, grade and school, the number of years of French studies, as well of the teacher's name.**

How to participate?

- Create your drawing **while at school or at home**, submit it by **March 9** at the latest to the Consulate General of France (address below), **and attend the Awards Ceremony at the Francophonie Picnic on March 12** (at the Atlanta International School 11am – 3pm).
- A jury made up of three members from the Francophonie Committee will select the winners, who will be announced on the website (<http://www.francophonieatlanta.org/>) on March 10 as of 5.30pm. **The winners will receive their prizes at the end of the Francophonie Picnic on March 12.**
